



Put A Ring On It Quilt™

Disappearing Rings Recipe

Do you want to make the cover quilt? Here is the 'recipe' for that quilt. It is a baby quilt size that you can make with or without corners.

Most of the quilt is made of low volume fabrics with strategically placed rings or partial rings in five colors.

I just pulled fabrics from my stash so it works well for scraps. I tried to have a different fabric for each piece in a ring. There are about 10 low volume prints but more wouldn't be bad.

- Low volume Arcs are single fabric A1 Arcs
- Colored Arcs are the two fabric A2 Arcs
- Cornerstones on the colored rings are all one fabric which is also used for the binding

If you want to make a larger version of this quilt then use the coloring page to decide which additional rings to 'color' with fabric.
