

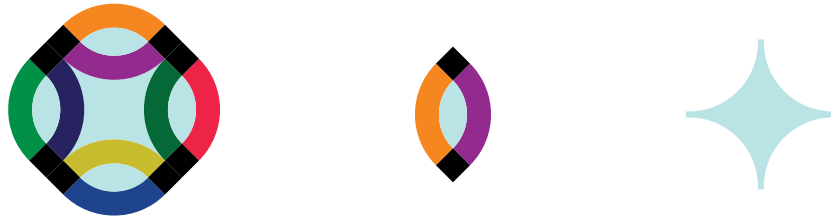


Put A Ring On It Quilt™

Pattern Hack 1: Blocks On Point

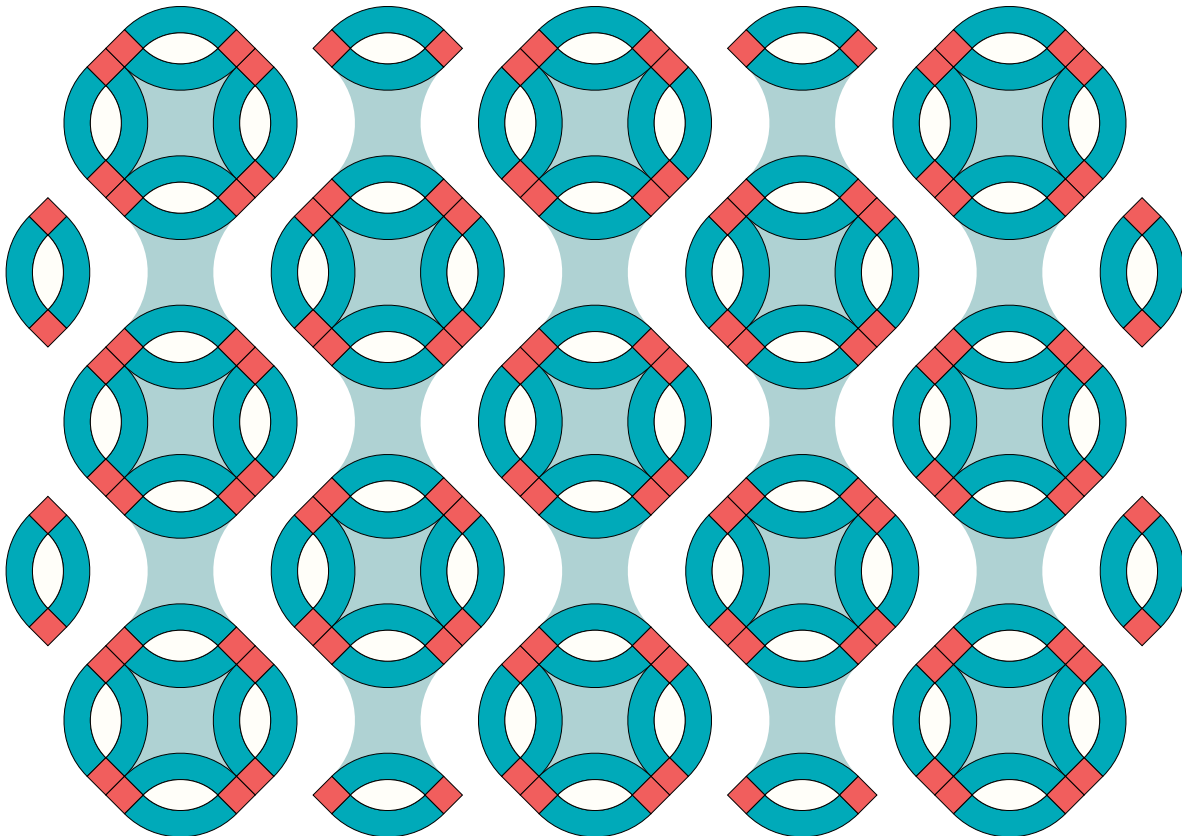
Rotating the Put A Ring On It Quilt™ block 45° AND sewing it together slightly differently you can achieve the classic scalloped edge of many double wedding ring quilts. Here's a quick visual on how it goes together and a few quick layouts for you for the 8" and 12" Clammy Version as well as the 16" and 24" Clammy Version

The main difference is that this version does not include Corners (B) or Edges (C). Only Arcs (A), Orange Peels (D), Centers (E) and Cornerstones (F). These go together to form the three building blocks of the quilt: Rings, Petals and Centers:

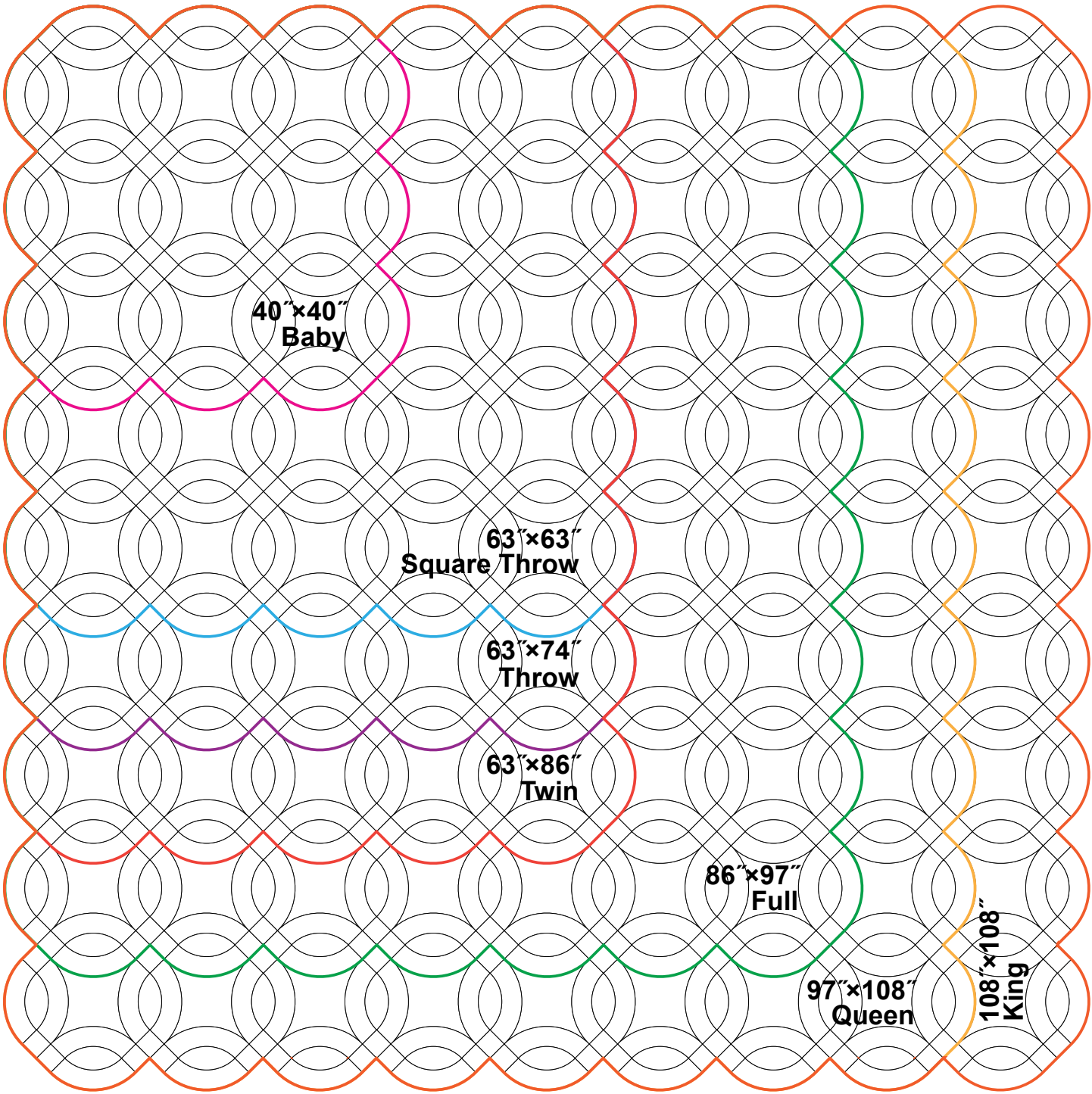


Assembly

Rows are now vertical and made of Rings and Centers and may begin or end with a Petal. The wavy rows are sewn together similar to the rows in the standard Put A Ring On It Quilt™.

Note: Due to the size of the 'blocks' on point this quilt made with the 16" and 24" Clammy templates yields unusual finished quilt sizes - hence the Small, Medium and Large designations.
